| <p>Works toward the achievement of group goals.</p> | <p>___ 3 Student <i>always</i> helps the group identify and complete goals. The student requires no prompting.</p> <p>___ 2 Student <i>consistently</i> helps group meet goals. However, prompting is required to identify or meet those goals.</p> <p>___ 1 Student <i>rarely</i> helps group complete goals.</p> |
| <p>Demonstrates effective interpersonal skills.</p> | <p>___ 3 Student <i>always</i> actively promotes effective group interactions, e.g. asking questions of clarification, sharing relevant opinions, encouraging, etc. between members.</p> <p>___ 2 Student <i>consistently</i> promotes effective group interactions between members; however, although the student is encouraging some of their interactions are “off-task” in nature.</p> <p>___ 1 Student <i>rarely</i>, if ever, participates in group discussion without prompting; comments made by the student derail or delay the group from successfully meeting its objectives.</p> |
| <p>Contributes to group maintenance.</p> | <p>___ 3 Student <i>always</i> helps group transition from one question to the next; they identify times when it is necessary for the group to change topic.</p> <p>___ 2 Student <i>consistently</i> does not impede (prevent) the group from transitioning from one question to the next; they cooperate when it is necessary for the group to change topic.</p> <p>___ 1 Student rarely, if ever, helps group transition from one question to the next; they might even impede the process of transitioning by their behavior.</p> |
| <p>Effectively performs a variety of roles within a group.</p> | <p>___ 4 Student demonstrates an ability to perform a wide range of roles within a group.</p> <p>___ 3 Student demonstrates an ability to perform different roles within a group.</p> <p>___ 2 Student demonstrates an ability to perform a restricted range of roles within a group.</p> <p>___ 1 Student does not demonstrate an ability to change roles within a group.</p> |
