

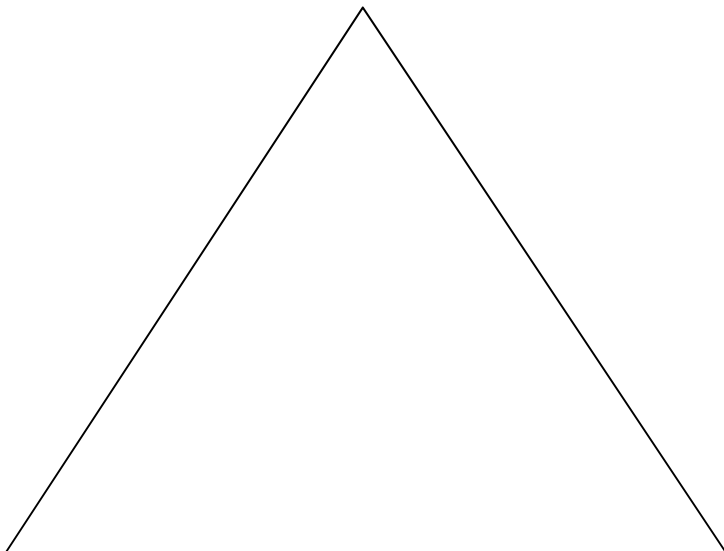
Unit 2: Activities 2.2 Worksheet
