

**Synopsis Assignment**

**A. Identify and describe (as a single sentence) a combination of *five* events, personalities, concepts, documents or locations you believe are the most important we've covered during this unit.** You might end up just identifying five events and no personalities or *vice versa*. Use your judgement to assess the important of topics studied for the unit. **The maximum word count is 40.**

In the left most column (grey), rank your reasons from most important (1st) to least important (5th). In the second half of the column (white), define/describe the event you've identified.

**Note:** you can write your responses in any order you like. Just make sure to rank them from most to least important.

**B. Write a detailed summary for each event, personality, concept, etc. identified above, write a paragraph (minimum 100 words each).** In your summary, provide an introduction and then a full description of the event, personality, concept, etc. **The minimum word count is 100 words.**

Write one concluding paragraph for each of the five identified concepts, personalities, events, etc. where you explain this event's overall importance to Canadian history.** As an alternative approach, you could explain how you believe Canada's history would've followed a different path if the concept, personality, event, etc. did not take place (or exist). **The minimum word count is 100 words.**
